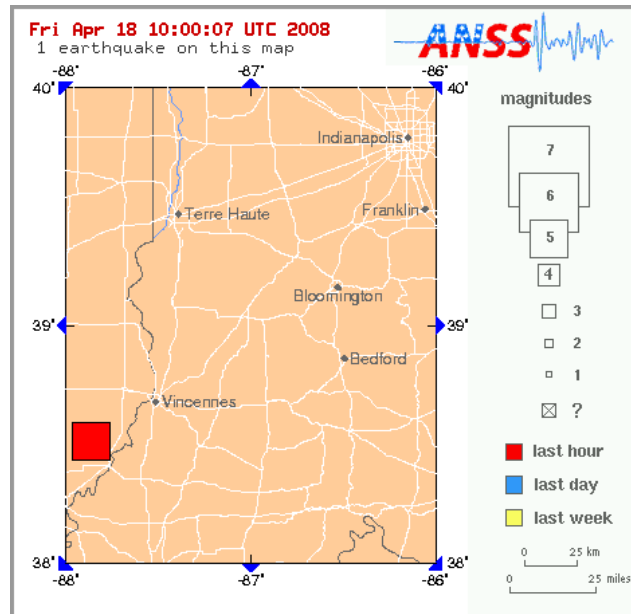




## Earthquake Hazards Program
